3. Referee In Chief's Report – Steve Harrison

- a. Statement of Understanding / PRC Verification form
 - Officials who did not fill out SOU / PRC forms last meeting were asked to fill them out at this meeting.
- b. HEO / District Meetings
 - These meetings are where any issues can be discussed and addressed at a higher level; it's important to hear from you if you experience anything unusual in your games so that we can address them.

4. Secretary Report - Neil Armstrong

- Police Record Checks (PRC) all officials doing games for Cumberland district are up to date for their PRCs.

5. Assignors Reports

a) House League (HL) - Lucio Paiano

- Assigning is normally being done 2-3 weeks ahead as there have been many schedule changes.
- There are fewer games to go around in December due to the Christmas holidays.
- November 29 December 1, U11/U13 house league tournament ensure your availability is up to date on the
 website block off the Friday during the day if you are not available. Officials will be emailed once all games
 have been assigned.
- SHADOW games will be assigned during the tournament where possible. All remaining SHADOW games should be completed in December, if officials' availability permits.
- Bell Capital Cup (December 27-31)— organizers expecting a significant increase in teams participating, including international games. Likely we will get a mix of house league and competitive games. They are often assigned on short notice, so your availability needs to be kept up to date for this period.

b) Competitive - Serge Gervais

- Rep B tournament was very successful with a lot of positive feedback, including from NHL referees. Great job!
- Some officials did a lot of games, some did not make themselves available, so we had to give away a couple of pads to other districts to cover.
- There were some issues where officials were marked as available even though they were not, which highlights the importance of keeping availability up to date.
- November assigning complete, December assigning underway, fewer games in December as with house league.

- 150 shadows / supervisions completed to date. Supervisors have until tonight to upload any supervisions completed. Supervisors will receive a warning for first offense for not completing in time.
